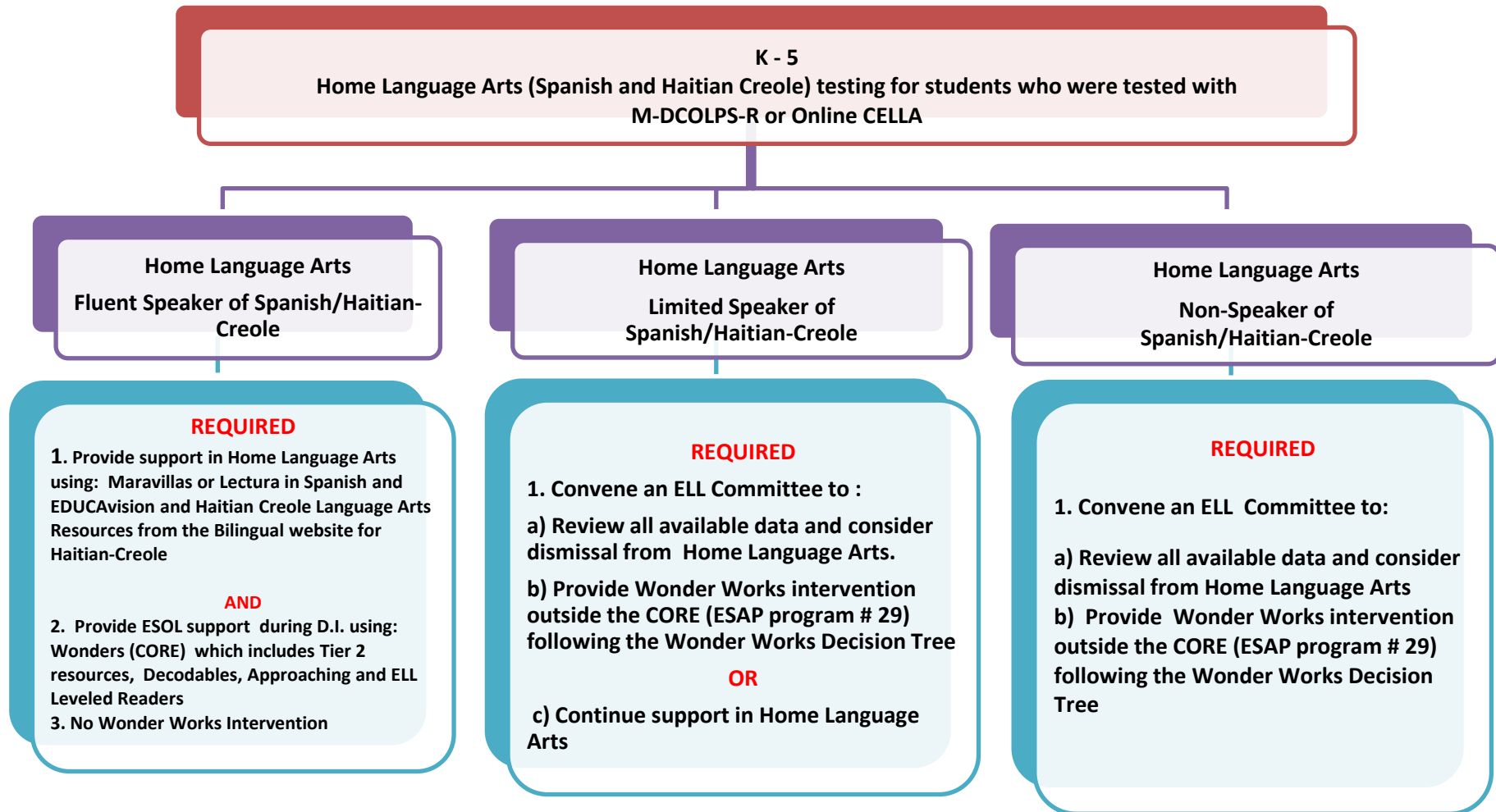


## INTERVENTION FRAMEWORK FOR **NEWLY CLASSIFIED** ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS (ELLs)

- It is recommended that all **NEWLY** classified ELL students ESOL levels 3 & 4 in grades K-5 who are having significant difficulties in Reading and whose Home Language Arts teacher indicates that they are limited in the home language, be tested with a Home Language Arts assessment\* in the Listening/Speaking component. The assessment should be administered as soon as possible to ensure they receive the most appropriate and timely support for English language acquisition. **NEWLY** classified ELL students ESOL levels 1 & 2 in grades K-5 will have HLA as their intervention.

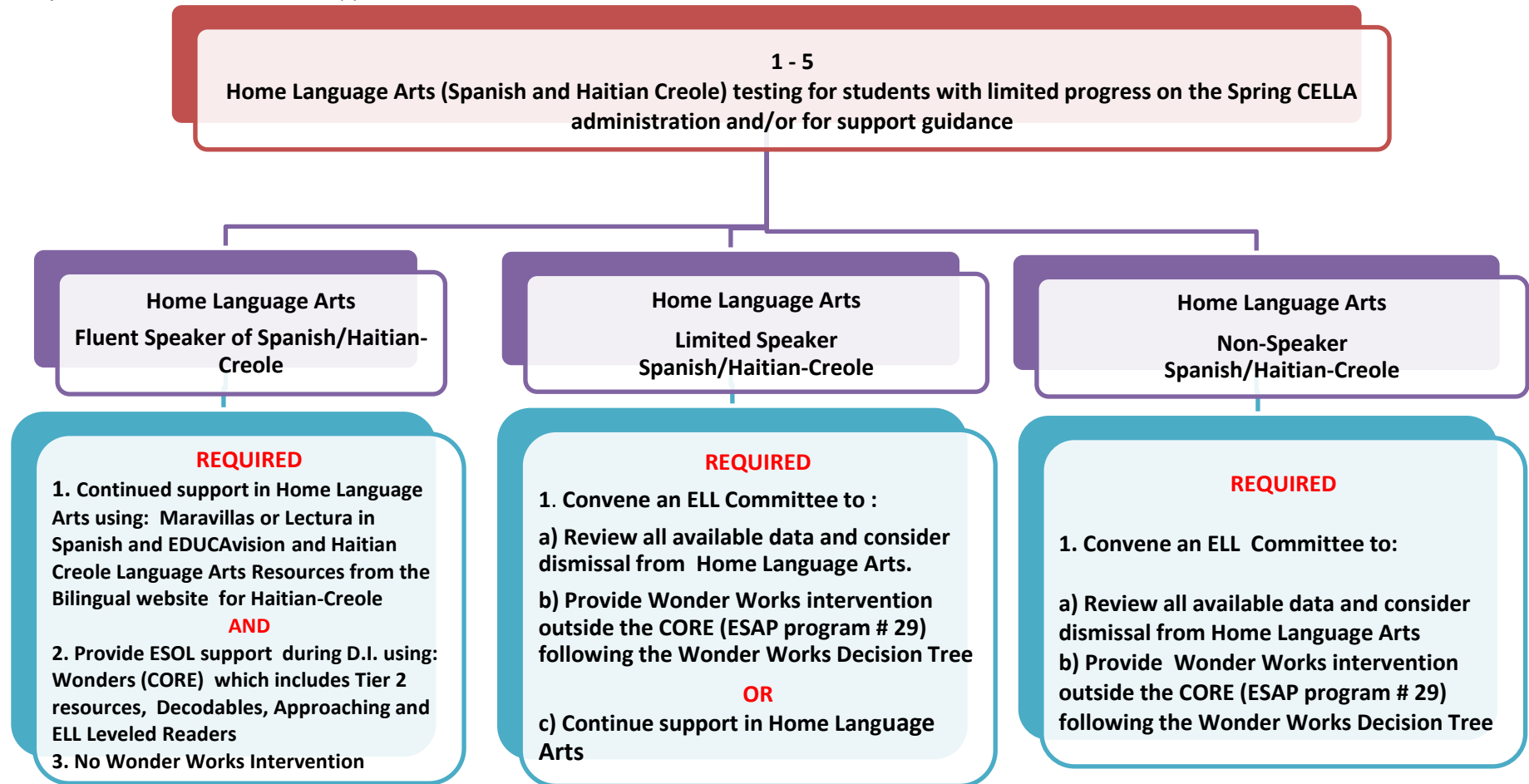
## INTERVENTION FRAMEWORK FOR **PREVIOUSLY CLASSIFIED** ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS (ELLs)

2. **Mandatory** Home Language Arts assessment\* for:

- **ALL** ELL students, levels 1-4, in grade 1 who do not show an increase in the Listening/Speaking component of the 2015 Spring CELLA **OR** demonstrate significant academic difficulties in Reading based on all available data.
- **ALL** ELL students, levels 1-4, in grades 2 -5 who:
  - Show a decrease in ESOL level on the 2015 Spring administration of the CELLA **AND/OR**
  - Demonstrate significant academic difficulties in Reading based on all available data **AND/OR**
  - Remain at the same ESOL level for three or more years.

*Testing must take place within the **FIRST NINE WEEKS** of school. Control-D CELLA report provides a comparison of scores between 2014 and 2015.*

3. If ELL students show signs of difficulty in Reading based on applicable data, then a teacher may request Home Language testing at **ANY TIME** throughout the year in order to determine support needs.
