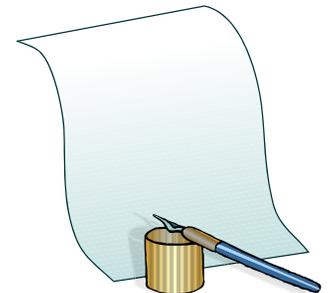


# CHARACTERISTICS OF:

Characteristics of a Fictional Narrative	Characteristics of a Historical Fictional Narrative
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>❖ Tells an imagined story</li><li>❖ Focused on one event that appears to be significant to the writer</li><li>❖ Orient the reader-establish the situation and introduce narrator/character</li><li>❖ Needs to include the elements of a story (narrator and/or characters, setting, organized event sequence- that unfolds naturally)</li><li>❖ Movement through time with temporal words/phrases</li><li>❖ Dialogue</li><li>❖ Descriptions of actions, thoughts and feelings to develop experiences, events or reactions of characters</li><li>❖ Use concrete word, phrases and sensory details to convey experiences and events</li><li>❖ Provide a sense of closure</li><li>❖ Conclusions that follow from the narrated experiences</li><li>❖ Is reflective</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>❖ Tells a fictitious story set in the past</li><li>❖ Surrounded by historical circumstances</li><li>❖ Conforms to the details of established facts</li><li>❖ Needs to include the elements of a story (narrator and/or characters, setting, organized event)</li><li>❖ Movement through time with temporal words/phrases</li><li>❖ Dialogue</li><li>❖ Descriptions of actions, thoughts and feelings to develop experiences, events or reactions of characters</li><li>❖ Use concrete word, phrases and sensory details to convey experiences and events</li><li>❖ Provide a sense of closure</li><li>❖ Conclusions that follow from the narrated experiences</li><li>❖ Is reflective</li></ul>

<b><i>Informative/Explanatory Writing:</i></b>	<b>Personal Expository/ Opinion Essay</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ <i>Examines a topic</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Conveys ideas and information clearly</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Provides general observation and focus</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Groups related information logically</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Formatting includes:</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Headings, subheadings; illustrations and multimedia when useful in aiding comprehension</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Develops topic with facts, definitions, concrete details, quotations or other information related to topic</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Uses linking words and phrases that connect opinion and reasons</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Uses precise and domain- specific vocabulary to inform or explain the topic</i></li> <li>❖ <i>Provide a concluding statement or section related to the information or explanation presented.</i></li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ States an opinion or point of view</li> <li>❖ Includes an organizational structure that lists reasons that support/prove the opinion               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Descriptive details</li> <li>❖ Concrete proof</li> <li>❖ Facts</li> <li>❖ Includes others who have the same opinion(quote)</li> <li>❖ Includes comparisons</li> <li>❖ An anecdote that supports the topic</li> </ul> </li> <li>❖ Uses linking words and phrases that connect opinion and reasons</li> <li>❖ Uses precise and domain- specific vocabulary to inform or explain the topic</li> <li>❖ Presents reasons in order of importance</li> <li>❖ May include an opposing viewpoint</li> <li>❖ Provides a conclusion related to the opinion/explanation</li> </ul>
